



May I Publish/ Broadcast this Witness's Image?

State's witnesses

Experts	Police Witnesses	Lay persons	
---------	------------------	-------------	--

No restrictions (unless there is a special order in respect of a particular expert witness, for instance, that no photographs of the exhibits shown during the witness's testimony may be published/ broadcast)

No restrictions (these are witnesses who are currently, or were formerly, members of the police)

Objecting witnesses*

Non-objecting witnesses

Public figures

Private witnesses

No restrictions (unless a particular witness has made his/ her consent subject to particular conditions)

Example:
Professor Gert Saayman -
Images of Professor Saayman may be published/ broadcast, but the images of the deceased's body which were shown in the courtroom must not be (unless there is a subsequent court ruling)

Examples:
Colonel Johan Vermeulen
Captain Francois Moller
Captain Christian Mangena

No images until the witness has been excused by the court after re-examination by the State

No images until the end of the trial

*Objecting witnesses are witnesses who have objected to their testimony being televised.
